

Integration courses at the vhs Lindau

PROCEDURE

An integration course consists of a **language course** (modules 1-6) and an **orientation course**. In the integration course you will learn German up to level B1. In the orientation course you will learn about German regional studies, history and politics. Each of the 7 modules lasts 100 teaching units. One teaching unit is 45 minutes.

After module 6, you will have a language test - the "**Deutschtest für Zuwanderer**". After Module 7, you will take a test on German regional studies, history and politics - the "**Leben in Deutschland**" test.

Both tests together result in the **Integration Course Certificate**. The integration course certificate is a prerequisite for a settlement permit or naturalisation.

COSTS OF THE INTEGRATION COURSES

- **0 €** per module for those on a low income, for recipients of citizen's allowance and unemployment benefit, recipients of housing benefit or recipients of other benefits
- BAMF: **229 €** per module (50% of the participation fees reimbursed under certain conditions)
- Self-payers: **458 €** per module

Please bring the following documents with you:

- ID (identity card or passport)
- Residence permit or residence title (not necessary for German citizens)
- Bank account details

If you receive social benefits, e.g. citizen's allowance, unemployment benefits, housing benefits, please bring the following documents with you:

- Proof of citizens allowance, current valid notification
or
- Proof of unemployment benefits, currently valid notification
or
- Proof of housing benefits, currently valid notification
or
- Other proof of social benefits

If you do not receive social benefits but have low income, please bring the following documents with you:

- Payslip of the last month
and
- Proof of child benefit for all children
